This letter is to notify you that the Advanced Health Education Center training course, "Human Trafficking Prevention for Healthcare Personnel" (the Course), is approved by the Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) in accordance with House Bill 2059 (2019) as of June 15, 2021. With this approval, the Course will be added to the [list of HHSC-approved trainings](#) for health care practitioner licensure renewal requirements.

The Course, as revised by Advanced Health Education Center on June 8, 2021, meets all required HHSC Human Trafficking Training Standards.
